



BALANDRA 2007

The name of "Balandra" (Sloop) locks in itself the meaning of our cellar: our house is called this way that it also gives name to the street where it is located, in the town of Torroja of the Priorat. The derived name of Balandra of the word "sloop", it was the habit that dressed the monks Carthusian, old residents of the Cellar, during the XVI century.

Harvested from September 27 on, fermented to 27 degrees and with 2 overcome daily, with those that it was extracted the colors, aromas and other substances that give him complexity. Aged during 12 months in new casks of American oak (Tennessee's fine grain) and a minimum of 6 months resting in bottle in our bottle holder (17: of constant temperature, 67-75% humidity, silence and darkness). We have gotten a wine with a lot of body, but elegant and subtle at the same time. A wine without a doubt with a lot of personality. A wine that will be to point in April of the 2011, and with a great upward life. Our Balandra is an tint of guard.

Coupage:

- 40% selection of old "garnacha" 50 years old
- 40% selection of old "cariñena" 50 years old
- 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Note: High intensity in the cherry shade and complexity in the bouquet, pepper and woods. Very silky in mouth with a great potential.
